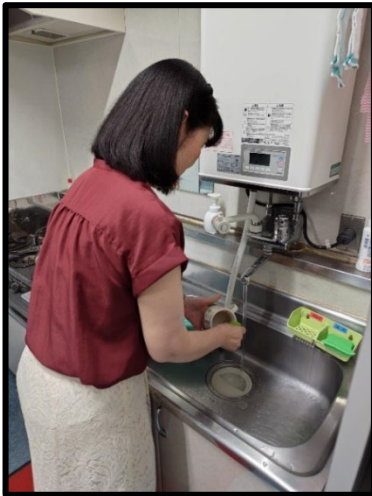

The next morning Jack was surprised to see a big (*1)beanstalk beside the window. “It must be the magic beans.” said Jack, and started to climb (エ)it. He climbed and climbed until he reached the (オ. 空). On a cloud, Jack (カ) [find] the castle of a giant and his wife.
